

CHANGES TO STAFF COSTS



From the 1st April 2025 there are some significant changes to your payroll costs:

- National Minimum Wage increases to £12.21ph from £11.44ph
- Employer's National Insurance rate increases to 15% from 13.8%
- Employer's National Insurance payable on annual income over £5,000pa, was £9,100

SHAREHOLDINGS IN LIMITED COMPANIES



As service delivery evolves, Limited companies are being used to deliver APMS contracts, incorporate PCNs, CICs or offer other health provider options outside of General Practice.

Have you considered if your practice's partnership agreement, or the Limited company's shareholder agreement covers changes in membership?

A Partnership is not able to hold shares in a Limited company. Usually this means that one "nominee" partner holds the shares on behalf of all the partners.

What happens if they leave?



- Is there a value to the shares held?
- Are shares automatically transferred to a new GP/Partner?
- Is the partnership agreement silent on this?

Review with your accountant and solicitor to make sure there are no surprises.

A GUIDE TO STAFF BENEFITS



During the course of a year the practice may have provided a benefit to its staff on top of their regular salary.

This could be in the form of health insurance, gym membership, gifts, or even the annual staff party.

If you have provided taxable benefits to your team then there is likely a tax charge, this can be dealt with by:

- Completion of a P11d, tax paid by employee
- Completion of a PAYE Settlement agreement, tax paid by the practice
- Payrolling the benefits from April 2026

Tax-free benefits could include:

- Staff entertaining if total cost is no more than £150 per employee (additional rules apply)
- Vouchers, if under £50 and not given as a reward for work or performance
- Salary sacrifice agreements
